### **Visual and Word Arts Competition with \$2,000 in prizes**

*This competition celebrates people with disabilities as part of our world and gives people a chance to express their perfect South Australia for people with disabilities in a way that we have never heard or seen. The idea for a competition was born out of Kelly Vincent MLC's love of words and art and her belief that these are powerful tools in shaping our world.*

#### **What you need to do?**

It is simple, all that you need to do is express what your perfect South Australia for people with disabilities is.

#### **How can you express yourself?**

You can express yourself through either of the two following categories:

1. Word Arts - essay or poetry (500 words or less) or video or sound recordings (5 minutes or less)
2. Visual Arts- painting, drawing, photography or sculpture

#### **Who can enter?**

It is open to everyone! Individuals with disabilities, carers, support workers and interested people as well as groups (classrooms, families, day options groups, organisations etc) are all invited and encouraged to enter.

#### **How will it be judged?**

Entries will be judged by Kelly Vincent MLC, on the “heart and soul” of their submission. There will be four prizes – two in each category, of \$500 each.
